


# **Our Profile**


A total of 4636 women were screened for cervical cancer

These support are focused mainly on personal interaction, advocacy, counselling, financial support, peer support programs and referral to appropriate medical professionals.





The BCS' services in facilitating access to timely and quality services, navigation, and counseling play a vital role as the Majority of the patients come from rural parts of the country with little or no knowledge of the services available.

The program provide patients with the resources and tools they need to manage their health effectively. This includes access to healthcare professionals, educational materials, and support groups.

The BCS facilitate these services through its WeChat group "Friends of Bhutan Cancer Society".



#### **RESEARCH**





Under the BCS' core program "Research", the Society initiated on a project to research on Stigma on Cervical and Breast Cancer.

The Ministry of Health supported the research with financial assistance.

#### **SERVICES DURING COVID-19 LOCKDOWNS**



The BCS partnered with the Bhutan Kidney Foundation to assist the government to contain the Covid-19 cases by providing transportation services such as:

- Transporting patients and their caregivers from home to hospital to undergo scheduled treatment;
- 2. Support with essential items to patients at Kidu Patient Guest House and others.
- 3. Facilitate with the delivery of medicines to the patients.

#### SUPPORT FROM THE PEOPLE OF JAPAN





the Under Grant Assistant for Grassroots Project (GGP) scheme, the Embassy of Japan in New Delhi supported the BCS' project "Provision of medical equipment and a medical van for the early detection of cervical cancer in women in far fluna areas of Bhutan".

The equipment handover ceremonial was held on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 in Thimphu with attendance by Her Excellency Ms. HOKUGO Kyoko, Minister (Economic and Development) and delegates from Embassy of Japan, BCS' Board Members, representatives from government agencies and CSO partners.

Under the project, the grant included:

- ✓ One unit of portable ultrasound;
- ✓ One unit of colposcopy,
- ✓ One unit of thermo-coagulation,
- ✓ Two units of Height and weight machine;
- ✓ Three units of head lights; and
- ✓ One Hilux






